



The Confucius Institute Scholarship/Confucius China Studies Program provides financial aid for students, scholars and Chinese language teachers for study, research, publication and much more.

For Professors and Researchers:

“Understanding China” Visiting Scholar to China (理解中国项目之访问学者项目)

The program sponsors assistant professors or above from foreign universities and academic institutes to undertake joint research in top Chinese universities from 2 weeks to 6 months. Excellent postdoctoral fellows are also welcome to apply.

Fellowship winners receive:

- 10,000 RMB per month;
- Round-trip international airfare (economy class, to be reimbursed against actual cost);
- Personal accident insurance during the visit term in China (we will buy for you. Reimbursement is not applicable.)

“Understanding China” Credit Course by Chinese Scholar (理解中国项目之中国学者赴外讲学项目)

The program sponsors Chinese scholars to teach non-language credit courses in foreign universities, and give lectures and host cultural salons in local and neighboring Confucius Institutes. The scholars can also carry out joint research with local scholars when available. The scholar shall be professor or associate professor in a Chinese university. The credit course

shall be in the field of humanities and social sciences, related to China studies. For credit courses of Chinese art, traditional Chinese medicine, martial art, etc., please consult with the contact officer (see below) in advance. The credit course can be taught by a Chinese scholar, or co-taught by a Chinese scholar and local scholar(s). The course duration can be short-term (within 1 month), mid-term (1-6 months) and long-term (6 months above, up to 1-2years).

“Understanding China” Publication Grant (理解中国项目之出版资助项目)

The program sponsors foreign scholars to publish or translate relevant monographs, doctoral dissertations, or founding relevant academic journals on Sinology and/or China Studies. The leading applicant must be non-Chinese citizen, and the book will be published in other countries and areas than P. R. China. The grant covers expenses for editing, translation, publication, circulation and advertising. The exact expenses will be approved according to the application.

For Ph.D. Students:

Confucius China Studies Program-Joint Research Ph.D. Fellowship (中外合作培养博士项目)

This program sponsors newly-enrolled or current Ph.D. students from a foreign university to pursue studies in a Chinese university from 6 months to 2 years. (HSK test score requirement: Level 3 and above)

Scholarship winners receive:

- Lodging and living stipend: 80,000 RMB per year
- Research fund: 20,000 RMB per year
- Round-trip international airfare
- Tuition waiver
- Other support provided by the host Chinese university
- Expenses for the foreign supervisor's visit or research in China
- Expenses for life and medical insurances in China
- Group activities and cultural experience

Ph.D. in China Fellowship (来华攻读博士学位项目)

The program sponsors foreign students to pursue full-time Ph.D. degrees in the humanities and social sciences at Chinese universities. (HSK test score requirement: Level 5 and above)

Scholarship winners receive:

- Lodging and living stipend: 80,000 RMB per year
- Research fund: 20,000 RMB per year
- Round-trip international airfare
- Tuition waiver
- Other support provided by the host Chinese university
- Expenses for life and medical insurances in China
- Group activities and cultural experience

For Undergraduate and MA students:

Confucius Institute Scholarship Program (孔子学院奖学金)

The Confucius Institute Scholarship Program will offer financial support for students for a period from 4 weeks to 4 years (HSK requirement varies by program). Applicants may select to affiliate with one of 158 Chinese universities offering courses in a variety of disciplines, including Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages, Chinese Language and Literature, History, Philosophy, Traditional Chinese Medicine, Music, Dance, and more.

Stipend as per Degree Programs:

- Master Degree Stipend for Confucius Institute scholarship is CNY 3000 per month.
- Bachelor Degree Stipend for Confucius Institute scholarship is CNY 2500 per month.
- Educational, residence, medical expenses covered

Application Deadlines:

a) April 19th (for programs commencing in July 2019)

b) May 19th (for programs commencing in September 2019)

c) September 19th (for programs commencing in December 2019)

d) November 19th (for programs commencing in March 2020)

Hanban will complete the scholarship review and publish the results three months before enrollment of the scholarship winners.

The 2019/2020 Chinese Government Scholarship is now open for application. Online application and corresponding application documents should be submitted no later than April 1st, 2019. The agency number for the Chinese Consulate General in Los Angeles is 8403. Applicants from the State of Arizona, Southern California, Hawaii, New Mexico and American Pacific Islands need to apply to the Consulate General of the People's Republic of China in Los Angeles.
